JR Hohi Main Line Limited Express ASOBOY! (Aso City)

Four years have passed since the Kumamoto earthquake that occurred in April 2016, and powerful and creative reconstruction is progressing in various parts of the prefecture. In August 2020, the entire JR Hohi Main Line was restored. The limited express "ASOBOY!", which runs dashing through Aso's magnificent caldera, was also back (lower right photo). In October, the "National Route 57 North Restoration Route" was newly opened, and the sight of the reclining Buddha that spreads when passing through the tunnel (lower left photo) brings out the new charm of Kumamoto and Aso. Furthermore, the majestic appearance of Kumamoto's symbol "Kumamoto Castle" is reviving step by step (upper photo). "Kumamoto no Sugata 2021" introduces the current Kumamoto with the latest statistical data.




10 Gross product and per capita income 2017 Fiscal Year

Kumamoto Prefecture is located in the center of the Kyushu region, with an area of about 7,409 km², which is the 15th largest in Japan, and about 60% of it is occupied by forests. Surrounded by relatively gentle mountains in the north and mountains at an altitude of 1,000 m from the east to the south, there are deep valleys showing the beautiful scenery everywhere. The western part faces the Ariake Sea and the Yatsushiro Sea, and continues to the East China Sea in the open ocean. It has two national parks, "Aso Kuju National Park" including the magnificent Aso with a world-class caldera, and "Unzen Amakusa National Park" consisting of 120 large and small islands, and has a beautiful landscape with mountains and the sea.
