



## The 'Heartful Pass' (Parking Lot Pass for People with Disabilities)

### Instructions for Use

- It is a pass card that allows you to park at designated spots located at public facilities, stores and shops, etc.
- It cannot be lent or given away to others, and can only be used when the person in need is riding the vehicle.
- It can also be used in parking lots outside of Kumamoto Prefecture. (However, this excludes Aomori, Kanagawa, and Aichi Prefectures.)

Types of pass	 <p>Green Pass</p>	 <p>Orange Pass</p>
For use	Available for people with physical disabilities.	Available for pregnant women and injured people.
Date of Expiration	N/A	Has an expiration date
How to return	If the degree of disability has decreased or the person is no longer eligible, please return the pass immediately.	There is NO need to return the pass. Please discard after the expiration date. It cannot be used anymore.






Please display your Heartful Pass in a way that is easily visible from the outside, such as by hanging it on the rearview mirror inside your car.

Please put a sticker on the back window of your car so it can be seen from behind.
