1 Kurokawa Onsen



At 700 meters above sea level, Kurokawa Onsen is a mystic town surrounded by ice and steam. Looking up from one of many outdoor baths at the constellations above is certain to heal your body and mind.

3 Uchinomaki Onsen

In the winter, Aso's Uchinomaki Onsen is a quiet hot spring town with spectacular views of the Aso five peaks capped in snow. Color your winter by exploring this retro town and enjoying dips in the various hot spring baths.

2 Shikiminoyu Onsen (Inside Kyukamura Minamiaso)



Shikiminoyu is a hot spring that softens and beautifies skin with its alkaline properties. It has a soul-soothing view of Aso's five peaks during the day, and at night, the starry sky creates an entirely new atmosphere.

4 Tsuetate Onsen



Tucked away in a steamy, snow-covered gorge, this onsen town has hot springs that run at 98°C and are great for your skin. Between its old-school pathways, foot baths, and steamed cuisine, this town is truly a delight to experience.

5 Minamiaso Onsen Village



This onsen town is home to five hot spring areas, each with its own unique mineral profile: Tochinoki, Tarutama, Jigoku, Hinoyama, and Hakusui. The town is affectionately referred to as "Gogakugoto," which likens it to the five peaks of Aso (the "Aso Gogaku").

7 Yamakawa Onsen



A secluded hot spring in the mountains with a host of ryokan. This hot spring area is known for its distinct sulfuric aroma and strong mineral profile that will leave your body feeling warm for hours.

6 Waita Onsen Village



This spot at the foot of Mt. Waita is home to a cluster of hot springs. These hot springs are unique for their 24-hour naturally flowing baths and the "Hell Steam" emitted as a result of immense geothermal heat.

8 Takamori Yusui Tunnel Park



Yusui Tunnel is a park in a tunnel with a ground-fed stream running down its center. The temperature inside remains around 17°C year-round, making it a warm attraction even in the winter.

9 Nabegataki Park



Visitors to this 10-meter-tall, 20-meter-wide waterfall can go behind the falls for a spectacularly unique view. The waterfall occasionally freezes in winter to form a magnificent wall of icicles.

Farm Village Ubuyama (Ubuyama Observatory)

From Ichiran Sanzan no Dai, stargazers can see the Milky Way and magnitude six stars, no viewing equipment required. Visitors can stay in a variety of accommodations, from private lodges to campsites.

10 Ogi Terraced Rice Fields



The Ogi Terraced Rice Fields are one of the Top 100 Terraced Rice Fields of Japan & 100 Best Rice-Growing Regions and have a unique appearance in each season. In winter, snow covers the terraces, creating a wonderland of icy silver.

Nakadake Crater's aura of power only increases in winter as its rough walls are covered in snow and the smoke becomes a billowing white cloud that looks like the warm breath of the Earth itself.

Central Aso

The Married Couple Waterfall is composed of a 100m "female" waterfall and an 80m "male" waterfall. The winter winds of the Aso Valley transform this waterfall into an impressive icefall in the winter months.

This course gives drivers a full panoramic view of Aso as it passes the white-painted five peaks, leaving visitors wondering if they've traveled to another world.

Sensuikyo Gorge Falls



This gorge sits at an elevation 900m above sea level to the north of Mt. Takadake. The gorge offers stunning views of the Aso Valley and the outer caldera. In the winter, icicles hang from rock faces formed from ancient lava flows.

Takamori Toge Observation Deck





Caldera Trail December



Mountain Biking in the Snow: 100-Minute Endurance Challenge February



A 1.5 km loop course set up to test participants' endurance and see how many laps they can do in 100 minutes. Rides can be done solo or in pairs. Afterwards, take a break in the rest space and enjoy a view of the winter landscape.

The scene of illuminated cherry blossoms combined with a low-lit shrine gate looks straight out of a fantasy and gives visitors a chance to enjoy the season even after dark.

Standing in the pastures of the caldera's southern edge, this 90-year-old cherry blossom tree commands a fantastic view of the Nango Valley. The tree was nicknamed "Kannon Sakura" because there's a statue of Bato Kannon nearby.

31 Shinshu Express Feb. - Mar.

On this special Minamiaso Railway train, riders can taste freshly brewed Reizan sake made locally with Aso water and rice as they watch the five peaks of Aso go by their window.

Shinshu to Furusato no Aji Festival Sake Kasu Walk

Held every year from February to March, this festival focuses on tasting the newly finished batch, called "shinshu," of Yamamura Sake Brewery's Reizan sake. Enthusiasts from all around the country gather every year for this unique shinshu.

In a ritual said to originate from a wedding of the gods, brave participants spin rings of fire, bathing the shrine in color and generating a spectral atmosphere.


